
REGULAR BUSINESS

October 8, 1985

- Sept 6 Last Day to Register to vote in Town Election.
- Sept 10 "NOTICE OF ELECTION" publication dates.
17 This notice must be published in a local newspaper,
24 once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, prior
Oct 1 to the election.
- Sept 10 Beginning date when candidates for office may
file a nominating petition.
- Sept 16 Council Meeting - Council adopt a resolution
designating three (3) persons, not candidates
for office, to act as Clerk and Inspectors
for the election.
- Sept 24 Final Date for filing petition - 12'noon.
- Sept 25 Notify news media of those persons filing petitions.
- Sept 25 Notify Okaloosa County Supervisor of Elections
of candidates.
- Sept 25 Prepare ballots for election (if required).
- Oct 8 Date of Annual Election - First Tuesday after
first Monday from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M.
- Oct 8 Election Clerk and Inspectors must certify results
of the election to Town Clerk immediately after
close of polls.
- Oct 8 Notify news media of election results
- Nov 1 Elected officials take office.

NOTE: Any candidate petitioning for election or re-election
must file a financial disclosure form. Petition and
disclosure form must be received by the Town Clerk
before the filing deadline, 12'noon, September 24,
1985. Clerk will handcarry all disclosure forms to
County Circuit Clerk's Office.

AGREEMENT

Comes now the TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, a municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Cinco Bayou" and the OCEAN CITY-WRIGHT FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT, and in consideration of the mutual covenants, the parties agree as follows:

1. Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District agrees to furnish fire protection service to Cinco Bayou beginning October 1, 1985, such fire protection service to be comparable to that furnished to the residents of the Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District during the duration of this contract. The Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District fire inspectors shall be permitted to make such inspections at proper times of such businesses and residences in Cinco Bayou as they deem necessary to determine compliance with the Cinco Bayou fire protection code (current fire prevention code adopted by American Insurance Association).

2. Cinco Bayou agrees to pay Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District annually for fire protection a sum equal to a millage rate of 1.768 mills times the assessment valuation of the real property located in the Town of Cinco Bayou prepared by the County Tax Assessor, allowing to the Town of Cinco Bayou the same discount percentage as is allowed by the tax assessor's office to each tax payer. The above sum shall be paid to the Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District on or before the _____ day of _____ during each year during the duration of this contract. In the event that fire protection services are furnished for a period of less than one year, then the aforesaid sum shall be pro-rated for the period of time that the actual fire service is furnished to Cinco Bayou.

3. That either party to this contract may terminate the same upon giving sixty (60) days written notice to the other party of their desire to do so, and any such fire protection service shall be pro-rated for the period of time the agreement was in effect.
