PRESS RELEASE

OKALOOSA COUNTY PREPARES FOR HURRICANE IVAN #1

The Board of Commissioners has declared a Local State of Emergency. This document is to provide Emergency Management the ability to purchase emergency supplies, to become eligible for FEMA assistance if needed, and other procedural abilities.

Okaloosa County Superintendent of Schools Don Gaetz has closed all Okaloosa County public schools for Tuesday, September 14, in preparation for the possible landfall of Hurricane Ivan.

General populace shelters will open tomorrow at 10 a.m. at Davidson Middle School in Crestview and Baker School in Baker. Special needs patients will be accepted at Davidson on a first-come, first-served basis with limited space available. Shelters should be considered a last resort for those patients and should only be used by those with no family help available or who are living in unsafe structures.

Okaloosa County will be issuing voluntary evacuation orders beginning 10 a.m. Tuesday for all residents of Okaloosa Island, all residents living in areas south of U.S. Highway 98 and all residents living in mobile homes.

Tolls on local bridges will be suspended as of 8 a.m. on Tuesday to facilitate the evacuation process.

Okaloosa County Regional Airport will suspend operations Tuesday evening at 11:30 p.m.

Citizens are encouraged to begin hurricane preparations immediately by boarding up windows, tying down loose objects in the yard, securing storage sheds, ensuring ample supplies of water, non-perishable food items, battery-operated flashlights and radios.

The citizen information line (651-7560) has been activated. It will be manned 24-hour-a-day until further notice.

Citizens are encouraged to tune into local radio stations and television for updated information on Hurricane Ivan and to visit the Okaloosa County Emergency Website at www.co.okaloosa.fl.us for information on disaster supply kits, evacuation routes, emergency orders, road closures and other vital local information.
