

1. PUBLIC HEARING - Proposed Millage Rate, Operating Budget, and Capital Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending 1983. Mayor Usrey opened the meeting noting that there were no Town residents or business persons present. There was no discussion on the proposed millage rate. The operating budget was reviewed item by item with only one significant change. Travel and Per Diem expensed for the Mayor and Councilmembers were increased to \$ 100.00 and \$ 50.00 per month respectively. The Clerk was directed to revise the budget accordingly, keeping the same total expenditure amount. The millage rate, operating budget and the capital budget will be reviewed at the next Town Council Meeting and will be advertised in accordance with the Florida Statutes for final review and adoption at a Special Town Council Meeting on Wednesday, September 29, 1982.
