

TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
September 16, 1976

Town officials in attendance: Council members Irene Balsley, Jim Kendrick, Will Overstreet, Harold Peek, and Max Usrey; Attorney Rick Powell and Recorder Dee Rouse. Absent: Mayor Ken Smith.

Also present were: Miller Burt representing Polyengineer; Honey Reeves representing Playground Daily News; Ruth Usrey, Adelia Robblee, Marjorie Crawford, Abbie Tyner, and Mrs. L. E. Watson.

Therefore, a quorum being present, Mayor Pro-Tem Peek took the Mayor's chair and opened the meeting at 7:31 p.m., with silent prayer.

1. MINUTES-REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING-AUGUST 19, 1976. Motion by Mrs. Balsley to approve as printed, seconded by Mr. Usrey. Motion carried unanimously.
2. FINANCIAL STATEMENT-AUGUST 1976. Motion by Mr. Usrey to approve as presented, seconded by Mr. Kendrick. Motion carried unanimously.
3. ORDINANCE-CLERK'S JOB DESCRIPTION-SECOND READING. Attorney Powell performed the second reading of this Ordinance #56. Motion by Mrs. Balsley to accept and adopt the ordinance as read, seconded by Mr. Kendrick. Motion carried unanimously.
4. RESOLUTION 76-3 - APPOINTING CLERK AND INSPECTORS FOR TOWN ELECTION. Motion by Mr. Kendrick to adopt resolution, appointing Marjorie Crawford as Clerk and Abbie Tyner and Adelia Robblee as Inspectors for Town election, seconded by Mr. Usrey. Motion carried unanimously.
5. MCDONALD PLUMBING-REQUEST FOR EXTENSION ON SEWER CONTRACT. Motion by Mrs. Balsley to grant a 30-day extension, seconded by Mr. Kendrick. Motion carried unanimously. (NOTE: Extends contract to September 29, 1976).
6. RESURFACING IRWIN AVENUE (BEAL TO EGLIN PARKWAY). Mr. Overstreet and Mr. Usrey were chosen as a committee to get with Mr. Miller Burt to discuss resurfacing Irwin Avenue.
7. POT HOLE ESTIMATE. Clerk informed Council that Mixon Enterprises gave him an estimated price of \$150 for repairing the pot holes on Irwin, Hughes, Lucille, and Kidd. Motion by Mr. Overstreet to have Mixon Enterprises repair pot holes, seconded by Mr. Usrey. Motion carried unanimously.
8. ADOPTION OF BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR FY 76-77. Motion by Mrs. Balsley to accept the budget as printed, seconded by Mr. Usrey. Motion carried unanimously.
9. CROSSWALKS-EGLIN PARKWAY. Clerk informed Council, as a matter of record, that he received an answer from the State saying that crosswalks could be placed only at intersections with traffic lights.

10. REPRESENTATIVE TO ATTEND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT MEETING. Clerk stated that he had received a request from FWB Council Chambers that a member from our Council attend this meeting being held on September 21, 1976 at 7:30 p.m. Mr. Overstreet volunteered to attend.
11. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION - "1976-77 PAVEMENT MARKING DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM". Clerk indicated that he had received a letter from DOT pertaining to Paving and Marking Demonstration Program. He also indicated that this Federal Aid Program 205 has been extended to municipalities as well as the state and county roads and there is no cost on the Town. Council agreed to accept this program.
12. REMOVAL OF STOP SIGN AT TROY. Mrs. Balsley recommended the stop sign on Troy at junction with Irwin be removed. Council directed Clerk to have stop sign removed from Troy and placed on Irwin.
13. ADJOURNMENT. Meeting adjourned at 8:13 p.m.
