Special Council Meeting Minutes
September 17, 1996

1. Mayor Drabczuk called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. this date. He asked the Manager to call the roll.

The Mayor Opens The Public Hearing.

3. Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate. The Mayor, in announcing the opening of the Public Hearing, noted the Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate and General Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 1997, was open for discussion. He said the public hearing is called to discuss the first reading of the Tentative Adoption of the proposed Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate of 2.300 which is equal to the roll-back rate of 2.300. He said the rate of 2.300 represents a zero percentage increase over the roll-back rate. Counsel Harmon reviewed the process.

4. General Operating budget for the FYE September 30, 1997. Mayor Drabczuk open the General Operating Budget for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1997, for discussion during the Public Hearing. The Hearing is the First Reading and Tentative Adoption of the proposed General Operating Budget. The budget is in the amount of \$208,363.00. The Mayor encouraged public discussion of the two items. Counsel Harmon introduced the budget summary.

No one spoke, or expressed a desire to speak, during the Public Hearing.

The Mayor, after calling again for public discussion, and hearing none, closed the Public Hearing.

5. The Mayor called for Counsel to read Ordinance No. 170. After Counsel read the Ordinance, the Mayor called for Council action. On a motion by Councilmember Chamberlain to approve the first reading and proposed adoption of the Ad Valorem Tax Millage Rate, seconded by Councilmember Kendrick, the roll call vote to approve was unanimous.

6. The Mayor called Counsel to read Resolution 96-06. After Counsel read the Resolution, the Mayor called for Council action. Councilmember Chamberlain made a motion to accept and approve the first reading and proposed adoption of Resolution 96-06. Councilmember Chamberlain made a motion to approve the first reading, seconded by Councilmember Beard, the roll call vote to approve was unanimous.

● Adjourn. The Mayor asked if there were any further business to come before the Council, and hearing none, adjourned the meeting at 6:04 P.M.
