

8. MEMBERSHIP - O IDC \$250.00. After a short disucussion, Councilman Usrey moved that we do not renew our membership in the O IDC, seconded by Councilman Peek. The motion carried unanimously.

9. ELECTION - OCTOBER 6, 1981. Clerk Borchik advised Council that, as of this date, we have one candidate for each vacancy. If there are no further petitions received by the Town Clerk by 12:00 noon, September 22, 1981, there will be no need for an election.

10. COMMITTEE REPORTS.

Streets/Sidewalks - Councilman Davis. Engineer Burt advised Council that a call for bids has been advertised for the first phase of sidewalk construction. To date, no one has picked up any drawings and specifications. The bid opening is scheduled for 5:00 P.M., September 29, 1981. Councilman Davis reported that the Town has purchased a gas powered sidewalk edger.

Parks/Beautification/Environment - Councilwoman Kelley. Clerk Borchik advised Council that he would like to purchase ten yards of oyster shells for Frances Park. Councilman Usrey moved that ten yards of oyster shells be purchased, seconded by Councilwoman Kelley. The motion carried unanimously.

Finance - Councilman Peek. No report.

Waterfront/Bayou/Health - Councilman Perry. No report.

Utilities - Councilman Usrey.


A. Water and Sewer. Councilman Usrey advised Council that we are going to discuss water and sewer with the County and are requesting a meeting with the water and sewer Director as soon as possible. The proposal presented by Fort Walton Beach is unacceptable.

B. Fire Protection. Councilman Usrey advised Council that he has contacted the Ocean City/Wright Fire District and a letter is being sent to the Commissioner to request a meeting with the Fire District on October 5, 1981, to discuss fire protection for the Town.

11. CLERK'S REPORT. Clerk Borchik advised Council that the Town Hall roof is in poor condition and must be replaced. We have one estimate of \$1025.00 which is a good price. Councilman Davis moved that we replace the roof at a cost of \$1025.00, seconded by Councilman Usrey. The motion carried unanimously.
