

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
October 1, 1968

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Lowell Taylor, Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of last meeting was read. Councilman Sonnenberg moved we accept minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Laritz. Motion carried.

Councilman Booher move we accept the finance report as read, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Attorney Estergren explained that originally our election of officers was set up for the month of October. For some reason it had been changed to Nov which conflicted with other elections. Councilman Sonnenberg moved we accept the committee to serve at the Polls, H. L. Roberson, Ian Crawford, and J.N. Olson as clerk at the Polls seconded by Councilman Laritz. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson suggested perhaps a gas heater would be more economical to operate than the electric heater now used to heat the City Hall. He explained now our yearly electric bill was based on a November demand meter basis. By installing a gas heater we would pay only a minimum yearly rate. Councilman Laritz moved we buy a natural gas heater and get it installed. Selling the electric heater for \$35 or using it as a trade-in on a new gas heater. Seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved we send \$20 to the Heart Fund in memory of Jack Prichard. Seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried. Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.
