

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
October 3, 1967

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Harold Peek, Lowell Taylor, Paul Hutchison, Edward Laritz, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Peek moved we accept minutes as read. Seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Several of the residents complained of mosquito being present and asked if we could have the low area's sprayed. Mayor Gibson suggested we call the Mosquito Control so that these area's could be sprayed.

Councilman Laritz moved we install a new street light on East Yacht Club Drive on the first curve, one-half way between the two existing lights in that area. Seconded by Councilman Peek. Motion carried.

Councilman Taylor moved we remove the dock at LaGunia Park, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson reported Mayor Roger Pryor of Mary Esther had contacted him inquiring the possibilities of our town being host, entertaining the municipalities jointly with Mary Esther and Laurel Hill.

Councilman Laritz moved we allow Mayor Pryor to be acting host at the dinner for the municipalities, seconded by Councilman Peek. Motion carried.

Mayor Gibson requested Attorney Estergren to set up the election for November 7. Mayor Gibson suggested we contact Marshal Disharoon to inspect the Ponderosa Steak Barn to control the grinding noise which is annoying to the surrounding residents.

Councilman Taylor moved we add paving to complete Opp Blvd at the cost of \$1059,90, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn meeting, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.
