October 5, 1964

Council meet at the home of Councilman Ronald Gibson. Present Mayor Gordon Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Paul Hutchison, Harold Peek, Ronald Gibson, and Ed Laritz. Three guests, Mrs. Ronald Gibson, Mr. Armstead, and Mr. Shawley.

Mr. Armstead and Shawley preposed a question and ask permission to open a used car lot at the Coney Island sandwich shop. Councilmen voted this as being out of town charter, then Mr. Armstead asked for permission to sell beer at the Coney Island Stand. He was referred to the Beverage Department.

Move to adjourn by Hutchison, seconded by Laritz. Motion carried.
