

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting  
October 5, 1965

Present Mayor Gordon Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Ronald Gibson, Ed Laritz, Paul Hutchison, and Harold Peek.

The paving of Hughes Avenue between Beal Parkway, estimate \$18,000 (Cinco's one-half and \$9,000 FWB's) Okaloosa Gas Company will advance Cinco town money's for the paving and gas tax Cinco gets will be payment on advance at no interest to Cinco, FWB will tax for one-half the amount. Motion made by Booher, seconded by Laritz. Approved by Council.

Discussion on building Town Hall, roads, shell for streets, Andalusia next in line for work. Water franchise FWB Attorney to draw up plans on the water franchise in 30 days to present that Cinco might get FWB to work up a solution.
