The council of the Town of Cinco Bayou met at 7:30 p. m.

Mayor Gibson called the meeting to order with silent prayer.

The minutes were read. The motion by Councilman Peek, to accept the minutes as corrected, was seconded by Councilwoman Booher and carried.

✓ Mr. Gagnon of Delecia's Bakery requested a permit to relocate the bakery. Councilman Laritz made the motion, to allow the relocation of the bakery if there is ample parking, Councilman Hutchison seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

✓ Councilman Peek reported Glenwood Park contains 7.6 acres and Jim Kendrick of Ricks, Kendrick and Stokes has offered his service as an architect.

✓ Mayor Gibson stated Thompson Construction Company had given to the Town scaffolding from Food Fair to be used in development. The Council requested a note of appreciation to be drafted to Thompson Construction Company.

Mayor Gibson informed the council of his meeting with the City Manager of Fort Walton Beach concerning a written agreement for fire protection.

Mayor Gibson read a letter from a city in Broward County requesting the Town's participation in a suite whereby all towns would be able to obtain the additional cigarette tax.

✓ Attorney Estergren is to check on the Town's status in receiving future cigarette taxes.

Mayor Gibson informed the council of the next meeting of the Okaloosa League of Municipalities. December 8th. Mary Esther is host.

The motion to send Councilman Laritz to the Annual meeting of the Florida League of Cities, October 22-24 in Saint Petersburg, and to pay all expenses was made by Councilwoman Booher and seconded by Councilman Hutchison and carried.

✓ Mayor Gibson said he would invite Mr. Burt of Poly Engineers and Mr. Echols our county Commissioner to our November council meeting to discuss individuals hooking onto the sewer line.

A total of 30 persons voted in today's election.

The motion, to adjourn, was made by Councilman Hutchison and carried.
