

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
October 25, 1951

Minutes of previous meeting read approved.

B. Gibson nominated road commissioner by Harrelson, unanimously
elected. The Council instructed the road commissioner to determine which
streets would be repaired and when the repairs would be made.

G. Gibson reported a visit from Mrs. Schofield, Opp, Alabama and said
that she requested him to tell the Council she didn't approve of incor-
porating.

J. Middleton was instructed to get deeds to the parks.

Ordinance #4 to be entitled; an ordinance levying a tax on sales of
election city and on sales of Butane, Hydrogen and other like gases used for
cooking, heating or cooling purposes and on sales of water and on telephone
service. Providing for the collection of such tax and providing for the
disposition of the proceeds thereof and prescribing penalties for the
violation of this ordinance was read in full. Upon motion made by
Harrelson, seconded by B. Gibson; unanimously vote was cast for passage
and the ordinance was signed by the Mayor. Three copies were delivered
to the Mayor for posting.

There being no further business, the meeting, upon motion, adjourned.
