

Town of Cinco Council Meeting
November 2, 1964

Present Mayor Gordon Gibson, Attorney Fred Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Ed Laritz, Ronald Gibson, and Paul Hutchison. Also a guest reporter from Playground Daily News. Several interested town people.

Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

Public hearing on proposal to re-route Troy Street from Kelly Street to Hughes Avenue. The hearing was held on closing Troy Street between Kelly and Hughes which runs through Ft Walton Lumber Company's property. No motion was made.

Councilman Laritz and Gibson made a report on street signs needed, 13 stop signs, 20 yield signs and 33 post were required. Booher made a motion that the signs be ordered, seconded by Hutchison; Motion carried.

Mrs. Willard of the Humane Society ask for the Council to select someone to serve on the board from Cinco Council, the Mayor ask Booher to contact the Humane Society and offer her service, mutually agreed on by all.
