

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
November 3, 1958 7:30 p.m.

Present: Billy Gibson, L.P. Disharoon, Fred Estergren, Elbert Davis,
and Millard Booher.

Mr. Disharoon called the meeting to order in the absence of the Mayor.
The minutes were read and approved by Billy Gibson. Elbert Davis seconded
the motion and the vote was unanimous.

A general discussion was held-Elbert Davis will see Dowling Phillips
about keeping our same water front and if he doesn't agree with same, Mr.
Estergren recommends that the fence be torn down to maintain the same num-
ber of feet on the waterfront.

Mr. Davis moved that no money be spent or contracts made except by
vote of the Council. Billy Gibson seconded the motion and the vote was
unanimous.

Discussion was held on the extension of the street lights and the
Clerk will get an estimate of number and cost of lights from the Gulf Power
Company.

Mr. Booher moved that the meeting be adjourned and Mr. Gibson seconded
the motion.
