

Town Of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
November 3, 1965

Present Attorney Fred Estergren, Mayor Gordon Gibson, Councilmen Paul Hutchison, Ronald Gibson, Ed Laritz. Four visitors were present.

Minutes of October 5 were read by Laritz. Motioned to be approved, seconded by Ronald Gibson.

Mayor Gibson read the water franchise set up by FWB. Cinco to pay 25% more than charged to FWB customers (which water users now do pay). Have separate meters for each dwelling with a meter deposit of \$10 per house but those already buying water FWB not to pay the connecting fee, as ask to have the connection cost of \$150. Strickers from the franchise for those now using water, also those now have meters not to make another meter deposit. First chapter of section four be stricker from the franchise (that's Cinco not to pay additional 10% tax on water). Cinco come with FWB runlives that not allow another franchise for 15 years with option that Cinco might buy from FWB. Motion to accept the agreement with the objections corrected as pointed out. Motion made by Laritz, seconded by R. Gibson.

Discussion on fire prevention with proper lines. Our class rating on insurance now ten with liver of water accurate will be class seven \$.50 a month would take care of fire service.

Discussion of Hughes Avenue as to what portion of paving Okaloosa Gas Company will advance on the project of the annually amount of taxes, gas, utility, they collect pending further study. Andalusia Street discussion to try now to work. Boats at Seaway Park were notified Aug 5 to exacuate in 30 days, they cleared out for a few days there returned.

Election notice set up for December 7th. Registration book to be open until Nov 26. November 21 date for petitions to be turned into Town Clerk prior of that date for those qualifying for nominations on Dec 7, 1965. Those selected to sit at the election day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. were F.L. Buckley, F.D. Roberson and Francis F_arris.

Request of State Road Dept to give left turn signals at Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Drive SA 85A signals are ready to go up, no one to erect them.

Motion to adjourn by Laritz, seconded by Hutchison, all in favor.
