

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
November 8, 1966

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Pro Tem Laritz, Council members Paul Hutchison, Harold Peek and Iva Booher, City Attorney Estergren. Several visitors were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motion made to accept as read by Councilman Peek, seconded Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Finance report, total deposits-\$2,357.47, bank balance-\$6,267.97, outstanding bills paid, Gulf Power Company-\$265.54, Sears Roebuck and Co. (conf table)-\$34.08; N.W. Office Supply (12 folding chairs) \$59.40; Warriner File Co. (for floor)-\$30.50; Alva Wall (work on Irwin St)-\$12.50; Playgroung Plumbing Co.-\$140.51; Okaloosa County Mosquito Control-\$500; Town Clerk (Sept and Oct)\$30; stamps- \$5 (100 each)reimbursed to Town Clerk); Ft Walton Lumber- \$134; Attorney Estergren retainers fee- \$25; Okaloosa Asphalt \$54.08 (street repair); Total- \$1,390.61

Announcement of General Election results from Clerk at Polls, Jacob N. Olson, Inspector Verna H. Dodge and Frances Farris. Ronald Gibson was elected Mayor; Councilman Peter Sonnenberg, Paul Hutchison, Lowell Taylor, Town Clerk, Irene E. Balsley, Town Marshal, L.P. Disharron.

A motion was made by Councilman Peek Blk 13 and 16 be rezoned from R1 to a C2 general commercial district, seconded by Council Hutchison. Motion carried. Richard Light request Blk 21 (3 lots, 1 blk) on west Kelly Avenue be rezoned from R1 to C2 commercial Attorney Estergren stated he would be required to mail a letter to the Town of Cinco.

A motion made by Councilman Hutchison, we \$10 membership dues that our Mayor would be a member of the Florida League of Municipalities which will give him power to vote on County wide issues.

Attorney Estergren reported he had received no reply from the letter

written Mr. Lee, State Road Dept in reference to the turn of signal at Yacht Club Drive and Eglin Parkway.

Mayor Pro Tem Ed Laritz distributed maps with outlined Cinco area to all Gas Co. to positive check to assure, we were receiving all tax monies due the Town of Cinco.

Motion by Councilman Hutchison we paint name Cinco Bayou Town and street numbers on front wall of building, seconded by Councilman Booher. Carried.

Councilman Peek moved we fill holes with oyster shells and do all necessary street repair so they will be in proper condition, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

Mayor Pro Tem Laritz presented prices for heating system, \$110 gas heater, \$180 electric heater. Being the electric heater would require less costly installation Mr. Hutchison moved we purchase electric heater, seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion approved.

Councilman Peek moved we complete all necessary work on the City Hall including plumbing, cess pool, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.

A motion made by Councilman Peek we pay D. B. Publishing Co., \$47.90 materials purchased by Marshal Hicks, materials to be turned over to our newly elected Marshal L.P. Disharoon, seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

Meeting adjourned.
