NOVEMBER 27, 1979

1. HIRING OF NEW TOWN CLERK.

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Town officials in attendance: Mayor Irene Balsley, Council members Phil Johnston, Ralph Perry and Max Usrey; Attorney Rick Powell and Recorder Dee Rouse.
Absent: Council member Harold Peek.

Also present were: Steve Chew-PGDN, Adelia Robblee and Abbie Tyner.

Therefore, a quorum being present, Mayor Balsley opened the meeting at 5:10 p.m.

1. HIRING OF NEW CLERK. Mayor Balsley informed Council that she had received two applications for the position of Town Clerk. Mr. Usrey recommended that an ad be published in the newspaper to hire a new Town Clerk. He also recommended after the applications have been received, the Committee should review each and every applicant's application and present the ones that has been considered for the position to the Council for their approval. Mayor Balsley appointed Mr. Usrey to act as chairman on this committee. Mr. Perry recommended that the applicants should submit a resume' along with their application. Council agreed. Mayor Balsley directed Mr. Usrey to meet with her next week to write this ad. Later in discussion, Mr. Johnston moved that Mrs. Balsley acting as temporary clerk as part of her duties as Mayor be reimbursed at \$5.00 per hour for her services, seconded by Mr. Perry. Motion carried unanimously.
2. COUNCIL PERSON VACANCY. In a brief discussion, Mr. Johnston recommended that each Councilman go out and seek a citizen who would be interested in serving as Councilman for Cinco Bayou. Council agreed.
3. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION BIKE TRAIL DISCUSSION. Mayor Balsley informed the Council that she had spoken with Jim Baughman of Fort Walton Beach about the installation of the bike trail along Eglin Parkway. After a brief discussion, Mr. Perry moved that the Town join with the other municipalities in supporting the installation of the bicycle trail along Eglin Parkway, seconded by Mr. Johnston. Motion carried unanimously.
4. CORRECTIONS COMPLETED ON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN. Mayor Balsley informed Council that she had received and look over the corrected copy of the Comprehensive Plan. She agreed that Mr. Gill had made all the changes that were submitted by the Council on November 5, 1979 and that a motion was needed to approve the revised Comprehensive Plan. Mr. Usrey moved to accept the revised Comprehensive Plan and that it maybe forwarded to the State for review, seconded by Mr. Perry. Motion carried unanimously.
5. ADJOURNMENT. Meeting adjourned at 5:42 p.m.

No Action Taken on Vacant Positions

The Cinco Bayou Town Council met as a committee Tuesday night but took no action to fill two municipal positions recently vacated.

Council members discussed the open positions of town clerk-manager and of one council seat, but did not say who — if anyone — was being considered to fill them.

The clerk-manager position was vacated Nov. 20 by Kenneth Espy, who announced his resignation in a letter read at the Nov. 15 council meeting.

In the letter Espy gave no specific reasons for quitting the position, but said "conflicting instructions" he received had led to his decision.

Filling a vacant council seat also was discussed among the council members, who were encouraged by Mayor Irene Balsley to inform residents of Cinco Bayou interested in serving on the council to make their intentions known to the council.

The vacancy was created when Balsley was appointed mayor during last Thursday's council meeting.

Balsley succeeded Jim Kendrick, a local architect, who resigned for personal reasons.

In other action, the Cinco Bayou council committee Tuesday agreed to corrections to the ci-

ty's comprehensive plan. At a Nov. 5 meeting, the council had suggested that Mark Gill, director of the county planning department, include a provision in the plan that would ensure the rights of the town's citizens.

Council members agreed that the rights of the town are not subject to change by the plan. Powell assured council members that since the state allows for local home rule, they should not anticipate any change in the town's jurisdiction.

Powell said the plan should be treated as a guideline and reminded the council members they were empowered to amend the plan as they saw fit.

In an unrelated issue, the council agreed to reimburse Balsley for her services as acting town clerk, since she is functioning in that capacity until a new clerk is hired. Balsley said after the meeting that the reimbursement would be computed hourly, using as a base the \$7,800 annual salary the position carries.

The council also agreed to go along with other local governments in supporting the installation of a bicycle path along Eglin Parkway. The path, according to discussion among the council, would be installed by the state Department of Transportation. According to Councilman Phil Johnston, the path would be used for both bicycles and mopeds.

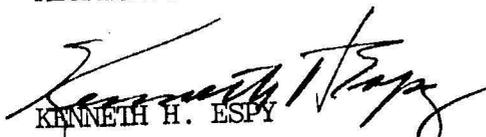
