The Special Meeting of the Town of Cinco Bayou Town Council was called to order at 5:00 P.M.

REGULAR BUSINESS

1. Building Permit - Moorings - Mr. Mike Plaster, LMP Enterprises, explained the planned changes for the construction of the Moorings, Phase Two. Councilman Laginess made a motion to authorize the County to issue a building permit to LMP Enterprises for the construction of five townhouses on Lots 13 and 14, Block 1, Cinco Bayou Subdivision, seconded by Councilwoman Balsley. The motion was unanimously approved.


2. Special Request - F. Sahlin - Mayor Usrey advised that Mr. Sahlin had requested permission to park a 24 foot travel trailer adjacent to his residence at 205 Opp Boulevard for approximately six months beginning December 1, 1984. After a brief discussion Councilman Laginess made a motion to deny the request, seconded by Councilman Gage. The motion carried 2 to 1 with Councilwoman Balsley voting nay.

Mayor Usrey advised the Council that a Certificate for Payment has been received from Quatre in the amount of \$8,762.00 for work on Glenwood Park Nature Walk for the period from October 26, 1984 to November 26, 1984. The work has been inspected and accepted by the Engineer. Councilman Gage made a motion that the payment be made to Quatre, seconded by Councilwoman Balsley. The motion was unanimously approved.




