Mayor Drabczuk called the Public Hearing to order at 5:30 P.M. following a silent prayer and the pledge of allegiance, roll call was taken.




A quorum was present. Also present was Town Manager/Clerk Nell Webb.

**SPECIAL BUSINESS**

1. **Second reading of Ordinance 189 allowing certain persons an additional \$25,000. Homestead Exemption.**  
Town Manager/Clerk Nell Webb gave the second reading of Ordinance 189.
2. A motion to adopt Ordinance 189 as written was made by Councilman Koch and seconded by Councilman Frucci. There was no discussion, the vote was unanimous.
3. **Motion to allow the Town Manager to direct the Town Engineer to proceed with core sampling of Hughes Street.** A motion was made by Councilman Carroll and seconded by Councilman Koch to direct the Town Engineer to proceed with core sampling for the purpose of testing the sub grade for future paving with an estimated cost of \$85. Per core – with approximately 6-8 cores plus approximately \$300. for lab fees. After discussion, a friendly amendment was made by Councilman Farley to allow the Engineer to proceed with the coring providing the core samples taken would be good for not less than 36 months. The motion was unanimous.
4. **Adjourn** – There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:45 p.m.
