

Town of Cinco Bayou Council Meeting
December 1, 1958 7:30 p.m.

Present: Gordan Gibson, Billy Gibson, L. P. Disharoom, Paul Hutchison, Fred Estergren, Elbert Davis and visitors-Mrs. Elbert Davis and Bill Clark.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor and the minutes were read and approved.

Gordan Gibson was sworn in as Mayor by Judge Fleet and the three councilmen-Paul Hutchison, Elbert Davis, and L. P. Disharoom were sworn in by the Mayor.

Mr. Bill Clark, representative of Gulf Power Company, gave the Council an estimate of lights he would propose for Cinco Bayou. A general discussion was held the council decided to let Billy Gibson and L. P. Disharoom contact Mr. Clark at a later date to discuss cutting down on the number of lights suggested and getting a definite price.

A discussion was also held on the failure of Ft Walton to come to an agreement on the water franchise.

Elbert Davis moved that the Council buy a typewriter and file cabinet and L.P. Disharoom seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.

Elbert Davis moved that the Council adopt a resolution stating that L.P. Disharoom be appointed Mayor Pro Tem to act in the absence of the elected Mayor. Billy Gibson seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Elbert Davis moved to adopt a resolution that any two of the three following persons be authorized to execute checks on the regularly appointed city depository: Mayor, Gordan Gibson, Mayor Pro Tem Disharoom and Joyce Noack, Clerk.

The Council meeting will be held at the home of Elbert Davis for the next few months.

Elbert Davis moved that the meeting be adjourned and L.P. Disharoom seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.
