PUBLIC HEARING - ORDINANCE NO. 119 - An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 112 establishing a fee of \$ 50.00 for each variance request. Attorney McInnis read Ordinance No 119 by title only. Councilman Gage made a motion to accept the first reading of Ordinance No 119, seconded by Councilman Skelly. The motion was unanimously approved on a roll call vote.

PUBLIC HEARING - RESOLUTION 88-6 - A resolution objecting to oil drilling and exploration off the coast of Florida and the Florida Keys without a thirty-mile buffer zone; requesting the United States Congress to oppose plans for any such drilling and exploration. Attorney McInnis read Resolution 88-6 by title only. Councilman Skelly made a motion to adopt Resolution 88-6, seconded by Councilman Davis. The motion was unanimously approved on a roll call vote.

ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 (D) OF ORDINANCE NO. 112 OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA; ADDING A REQUIREMENT FOR A FEE OF \$50.00 TO ACCOMPANY THE APPLICATION FOR REQUEST FOR A VARIANCE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 1(D) of Ordinance No. 112 of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1 (D). Application for a Variance/Special Exception: A request for a variance or special exception shall be submitted in writing to the Town Manager and be accompanied by the documents, plans, papers, specifications and other materials necessary to clarify and support the request and an application fee of \$ 50.00. The Town Manager shall receive and forward the request to the Board for consideration.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any word, sentence, phrase, clause, section or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion or word shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS. All ordinances and resolutions of the governing body in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and adoption.


