December 3, 1968

Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Iva Booher, Edward Laritz, Paul Hutchison, Lowell Taylor, and Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Taylor moved the minutes be accepted as read, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Carried.

Councilman Taylor moved the monthly finance report be accepted as read. seconded by Councilman Booher. Motion carried.

New officers duty elected Oct 8, 1968 were sworn to office by Attorney Estergren to take office Jan 1, 1969.

Mayor Gibson reported he had contacted Gulf Power to remove all the dead trees along the streets of the town.

Okaloosa Asphalt Company and Coastal Asphalt Co., entered bids for consideration by the Council to pave the remainder of Opp Blvd to Yacht Club Drive. Councilman Taylor moved to accept the bid made by Okaloosa Asphalt at \$9,625, seconded by Councilman Sonnenberg. Motion carried.

Councilman Laritz moved Mayor Gibson talk to Mr. Landreth about the sewage pipe to drain Hughes Avenue, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Carried.

Being no further business, Councilman Laritz moved we adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Motion carried.
