Cinco Bayou Council Meeting, 7:30 p.m. Present Mayor Ronald Gibson, Attorney Estergren, Councilmen Paul Hutchison Lowell Taylor, Edward Laritz, Constable Disharoon, Peter Sonnenberg.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Councilman Taylor moved the minutes be accepted as read, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Carried.

Discussion by Councilman to obtain method of using Cinco Bayou as part of address getting cooperation of persons in the town. This would help the utility companies in reporting sales tax. Some conclusion should be reached by next meeting.

Councilman Laritz moved to spend as much as \$100 on christmas tree decorations, seconded by Councilman Taylor. Approved.

Resolution passed by the State Road Dept to maintain care of street east of Yacht Club Drive after Jan 1, 1968.

Mayor Gibson reported on his meeting with Mayor Pryor of Mary Esther, discussing the Municipalities dinner. It was decided to wait until March of the first week in April and possibly have a fish fry and entertain individually.

Mayor Gibson gave a report of the years activities and accomplishments by the city and expressed his thanks to the city officials cooperation. Officials, duly elected to office Nov 7 were sworn to office Attorney Estergren to take office Jan 1, 1968.

Motion made to adjourn meeting by Councilman Laritz, seconded by Councilman Hutchison. Approved.
