Water franchise unable to contact Mr. Walker of FWB to discuss or make appointment.

Joe Morgan obtained an estimate of paving Hughes Avenue form Eglin to Beal. L.F. \$1.60, \$3,964.80; S.G., \$1.90, \$8,170; Curb, 2478 L.F., 7.10, \$2,769; Soil cement Street, 4300 LF 5.10, \$3,264; 36" culvert, 390 etc, 24" inlets, 5 etc, \$125, \$625; FWB one-half, Cinco one half of amount \$18,792.80. Okaloosa Gas Company would advance up to two years, ask for little to amount stating we desire to pave Street providing funds can be made available.

Mr. Estergren wrote State Road Department about the Eglin Parkway and Yacht Club Drive light has not received answer.

Town for Cinco in order to go to the bank and sign note for monies, would have to pledge a certain amount of ear marked portion of utility taxes without having a special election, estimate cost \$5000.
