The Minutes of the November meeting were read, Motion made by Councilman Peek to accept the Minutes as read, seconded by Councilman Johnston and so carried.

The Finance Reports of October and November were read, Motion made by Councilwoman Balsley to accept the reports as presented, seconded by Councilman Johnston, so ordered.

Councilman Johnston made a Motion to offer a Seventy-five Dollar retainer to Jim Godwin, for a period of one (1) month, to ascertain what his charge would be to handle the work that cannot be handled by the Clerk. Motion seconded, and so carried.
