



The Department of Environmental Protection recently awarded the Town of Cinco Bayou a \$50,000 grant from the Florida Recreation Development Assistance Program. This grant will be used to fund improvements to Winn Davis Park, the area around our Town Hall. I like to think of this funding as tax dollars we sent to Tallahassee being returned to our citizens for local projects. Your council members and the staff of the Town are always searching for additional dollars to utilize for projects that will benefit our residents.

This FRDAP grant will be used to construct a fishing pier on Kidd Bayou just behind the Town Hall. A boardwalk will be built from the parking lot to the pier and the parking lot will be resurfaced. Additional improvements include repairs to the back deck of the Town Hall and the purchase of additional picnic tables for the park. We hope these improvements will provide increased recreational opportunities for the citizens of Cinco Bayou and make the park more attractive. So get your fishing poles ready and let's hope the big ones are biting this summer.

CINCO BAYOU BRIDGE WORK

Superior Construction has been awarded the contract for the repairs to the Cinco Bayou Bridge. Superior Construction has been hired to replace all of the support bearings and pads that are between the concrete trusses and bridge pilings under the bridges at Cinco Bayou and at Garnier's Bayou. The project has a projected completion date of September, but with the unsafe weather conditions, the completion date may have to be extended. When speaking to one of the job foremen he said, "Even though the barges are large, when boats go by them at high speeds it makes our jobs very dangerous with the wake involved and it slows down progress". The Staff at Town Hall has been asked to spread the word throughout the community to bring awareness to the work being done and for all to be conscious of the workers on the barges under the bridge. Please be patient and courteous when boating, as the conditions that the boats create can be very dangerous to the workers due to the stability of the barges
