ORDINANCE NO. 184

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN BY ADDING NEW SECTION 6-3, TO BE ENTITLED CONSUMPTION, POSSESSION AND OPEN CONTAINERS RESTRICTED; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida that:

Section 1. New Section 6-3, Chapter 6, of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida is adopted as follows:

CHAPTER 6 ALCOHOL

Sec. 6-3. Consumption, possession and open containers restricted.

It shall be unlawful for any person to consume, induce, assist or aid another to consume any alcoholic beverage or possess in any cup, can, bottle, or other open or unsealed container any alcoholic beverage upon or on any public street, sidewalk, right of way, parking lot, in any alley, city park, city recreation center, or other public property within the city except when license for alcoholic beverage sales or official temporary authority is granted by the City for the purpose of special events on designated city properties.

Section 2. Severability. If any word, sentence, phrase, clause, section or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion or words shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions. All Ordinances and Resolutions of the governing body in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
