

ORDINANCE NO. 181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN BY AMENDING SECTION 10-2, ENTITLED APPLICABILITY OF COUNTY ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE APPLICATION OF THE COUNTY ORDINANCE PERTINENT TO ANIMAL CONTROL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida that:

Section 1. Section 10-2, Chapter 10, of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida shall be replaced in its entirety with the following language:

CHAPTER 10 ANIMALS

Sec. 10-2. Applicability of county ordinance.

Okaloosa County Code Chapter 5, entitled Animals and Fowl, as may be amended from time to time, and any successor ordinance thereto dealing with animal control, shall apply and be enforced within the Town.

Section 2. Severability. If any word, sentence, phrase, clause, section or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion or words shall be deemed a separate and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 3. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances and Resolutions. All Ordinances and Resolutions of the governing body in conflict

herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall apply prospectively and shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
