

ORDINANCE NO. 131

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU AUTHORIZING THE MERGER OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU AND THE OCEAN CITY/WRIGHT FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION AND FIRE PREVENTION SERVICES TO AND FOR THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA:

Section 1. In accordance with the provisions of Florida Statute 165.041 (4) and the concurrence of the Ocean City/Wright Fire Control District Commission, the Town Council of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, after due advertisement and required Public Hearings, approves the merger of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida with the Ocean City/Wright Fire Control District for the purpose of obtaining fire protection and fire prevention services offered by the Ocean City/Wright Fire Department.

Section 2. The Town Charter, Section III, paragraphs (a) and (i) are the authority for the Town Council's approval of this merger. Upon formal approval by the Ocean City/Wright Fire Control Commission, the Town of Cinco Bayou, its citizens, residents and all businesses, their owners and employees, shall enjoy the rights and privileges of the fire district and become subject to all rules and regulations, present and future.

Section 3. The corporate limits of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, are set forth in the Town's Charter and are restated for the purpose of this merger.

The boundaries of the Town of Cinco Bayou in Okaloosa County, Florida shall be as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of Section 12, Township 2 South, Range 24 West, Tallahassee Meridian, at the head of Bayou DeKidd, (or Irwin's Bayou - now known as Kidd Bayou) thence South to the Southwest corner of Section 12; thence east 160 rods; thence North on the Half Section line to the water of Five Mile Bayou; thence in a Westerly direction with the waters of Five Mile Bayou and the waters of Bayou DeKidd (or Irwin's Bayou - now known as Kidd Bayou) to the point of beginning.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and the passage of an ordinance/resolution by the Ocean City/Wright Fire Control District Commission citing the approval of this merger and the addition of the corporate limits of the Town to the Ocean City/Wright Fire Control District.
