

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-20 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, WITH REFERENCE TO VOTING PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF VOTING MACHINES AND/OR PAPER BALLOTS, REPEALING ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH SAID ORDINANCE; SEVERING INVALID PORTIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE; PRESCRIBING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. That Section 2-20 of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Voting at Town elections shall be by voting machine or secret ballot when voting machines are not available. The election clerk and inspectors shall certify the results of the election to the Town Clerk immediately upon the conclusion of the voting".

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of the ordinance in the whole or in any part hereof.
