

AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THAT CERTAIN ORDINANCE ADOPTED AUGUST 3, 1964, BY THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, AS AMENDED, BEING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A ZONING PLAN WITHIN THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA: CREATING THREE DISTRICTS, REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE LOCATION AND USE OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES AND LAND FOR TRADE, INDUSTRY, RESIDENCES OR OTHER PURPOSES, THE HEIGHT AND SIZE OF STRUCTURES, THE SIZE OF OPEN SPACES FOR LIGHT AND VENTILATION: ADOPTING A MAP OF SAID DISTRICTS, DEFINING TERMS USED: PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT, ENFORCEMENT AND AMENDMENT THEREOF, DESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF. SAID AMENDING ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT SECTION 6, C-1 LIMITED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT SUBSECTION (A) "USES PERMITTED", PARAGRAPH 16, SHALL BE DELETED AND REPEALED: AND PRESCRIBING AN EFFECTIVE DATE HEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 6, Appendix A of the Code of Ordinance of the Town of Cinco Bayou permits private clubs and lodges pursuant to Subsection (a), Paragraph 16, and

and

WHEREAS, the Town of Cinco Bayou objects to such activities in C-1 Limited Commercial District and desires to withdraw permission for the conduct of such activities, and

WHEREAS, there are no private clubs or lodges currently being operated within the Town,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained:

SECTION 1: That Section 6, Appendix A, of the Ordinance of the Town of Cinco Bayou is hereby amended to repeal and delete from Subsection (A) Paragraph 16, "Private Clubs and Lodges".

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective after adoption by the Town Council and approval by the Mayor.
