

ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14-1 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, WITH REFERENCE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AD VALOREM TAXES; PROVIDING FOR DECREASE IN THE TAX MILLAGE FROM 4.932 MILLS TO 4.478 MILLS UPON REAL AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF CINCO BAYOU, FLORIDA, ON 1 JANUARY 1980; REPEALING ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT WITH SAID ORDINANCE; SEVERING INVALID PORTIONS OF SAID ORDINANCE; PRESCRIBING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, that:

Section 1. That Section 14-1 "Ad Valorem Taxes

Established" of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"There is hereby levied upon all real and tangible personal property located in the Town of Cinco Bayou, Florida, on January 1, 1980, an ad valorem tax of 4.478 mills on each dollar of assessed value of such property."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Should any section, clause or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court to be invalid, the same shall not effect the validity of the ordinance in the whole or in any part hereof.
